RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLYING TO THIS SHOW:

- 1) Entry is voluntary. By entry, all exhibitors and competitors agree to be bound by the EA competition rules and regulations.
- 2) PIC documentation is required to be shown upon request.
- 3) Membership. \$12 membership entitles admission for 2 adults. \$16 membership entitles admission for 2 adults and 2 children. Both memberships include \$2 worth of free entries.
- 4) Money and completed waiver forms must accompany entry forms or they WILL NOT be accepted. Entry fees will not be refunded.
- 5) Horses competing in the EA Ring are not eligible to compete in Ring 3. All horses are eligible to compete in the breed rings provided they meet the criteria for their particular breed.
- 6) EA Swabbing rules apply. Random swabbing may take place at this show. Current EA measuring certificate will be accepted and is to be produced on request. All riders must wear boots and a helmet that is approved by the EA and complies with current Australian standards.
- 7) The Quorn Agricultural Show Society will not be responsible and are in no way liable for any accident, injury, damage, loss or any matter that may happen for any causes or circumstances whatsoever to exhibitors, competitors or members or their agents or to anyone on the grounds or to any animal or article exhibited or to any property brought on the grounds or for any other loss, claim, matter, circumstances or event whatsoever in connection with or arising out of or understood to be the Quorn Agricultural Show or any journey to or from the event.
- 8) The Quorn Agricultural Show Society reserves the right to refuse any entry, without assigning any reasons, no claim shall be made against the Society should entry be refused.
- 9) The Quorn Agricultural Show Society may change any judge without notice.
- 10) A judge's decision is final subject to all conditions being met. Maiden is any horse that has not ever been placed 1st at any Agricultural Show.
- 11) The Committee reserves the right to interpret all questions or incidents regarding or arising from this show without recourse. Their decision will be final. Where a class specifies the age of the Rider/handler; the age is as at show day.
- 12) Protests must be delivered in writing to the committee, no later than one hour, after the class in question. A \$50 fee must accompany the protest and will be forfeited if the protest is not upheld.
- 13) Only competent persons over 18 years are permitted to exhibit stallions. All stallions must be exhibited in a bridle with a bit.

- 14) The Judges and Committee reserve the right to remove any horse considered to be behaving in a dangerous manner from the grounds.
- 15) Any act that, in the Judge's or Committee's opinion, is deemed cruel or neglectful (eg excessive whipping etc) will cause the competitor to be removed from the grounds. Severe cases will be reported to the appropriate authorities.
- 16) Camping on grounds is permitted after 5pm on 24/8/13. There are no horse yards on site. Portable toilets will be available and showers are available for use on site underneath the grandstand. Also camping is available next door at the Stockyard Arena with a "first in first served" basis for use of horse yards. Fuel is available throughout the weekend. Town water is available on site for horses. No fodder available after 12 noon Saturday.
- 17) All dogs to be kept on a leash at all times.
- 18) No access to oval by persons other than Quorn A & H Show Committee and/or volunteers until gates open 24/8/14.
